Stewardship Reflections

July 1st, 2018

"Your abundance at the present time should supply their needs, so that their abundance may also supply your needs." This is the fourth time in 2 Corinthians, chapter 8 that St. Paul addresses the issue of giving. What Paul is trying to explain is that the motivation for giving should be similar to God's motivation for gifting us. In the passage which constitutes today's Second Reading Paul says, "As you excel in every respect, in faith, discourse, knowledge, all earnestness, and in the love we have for you, may you excel in this gracious act also."

In the original, Paul uses the old Greek word charis to describe the giving to which he is making reference. We can probably see that the roots of that word are very much the same as the roots of the word "charity." Giving and sharing are definitely the work of God's grace in us. In fact, our motivation should be very much the same as that of the Lord. He gives to us because of Who He is, not because of what or who we are.

We, too, must give if we wish to show holiness, or to at least aspire to it. That is also what we mean when we say that we are all called to stewardship, to be good stewards. It is one thing to be faithful, but it is another to give. At times we may think there are too many collections, but it is the results of these opportunities to give which support the Church's work both locally and around the globe.

Celebrate with Acts of Devotion

John Adams, one of the Founding Fathers of our country and later our 2nd President, wrote this about how to celebrate the 4th of July: "It ought to be commemorated as the Day of Deliverance by solemn Acts of Devotion to God Almighty. It ought to be solemnized with Pomp and Parade, with shews, games, Sports, Guns, Bells, Bonfires and illuminations from one End of this Continent to the other from this Time forward forever more." We do well in following his advice by celebrating with pomp and parades, with games and sports, with illuminations. But how well do we do in celebrating with "solemn Acts of Devotion to God Almighty"? This is probably an area in which we often fail. John Adams and our Founding Fathers understood well that we owe God more than anyone else for what occurred 242 years ago.

In fact, the most famous part of the Declaration of Independence explicitly points to God as the source of our freedom: "We hold these truths to be self-evident, that all men are created equal, that they are endowed by their Creator with certain unalienable rights, that among these are life, liberty, and the pursuit of happiness." Not our parents, or politicians, or government, is the source of our most important rights. Only God. As the source of our rights, he deserves the highest praise, honor, and glory on Independence Day (and every day).

So let be sure to celebrate this year with some act of devotion to God, as suggested by John Adams. Perhaps we could pray the following prayer that was composed by our first President, George Washington. "Almighty God, who has given us this good land for our heritage: We humbly beseech you that we may always prove ourselves a people mindful of your favor and glad to do your will. Bless our land with honorable industry, sound learning, and pure manners. Save us from violence, discord, and confusion; from pride and arrogance, and from every evil way. Defend our liberties, and fashion into one united people the multitudes brought hither out of many kindreds and tongues. Endue with the spirit of wisdom those to whom your Name we entrust the authority of government, that there may be justice and peace at home, and that, through obedience to your law, we may show forth your praise among the nations of the earth. In the time of prosperity, fill our hearts with thankfulness and in the day of trouble, do not allow our trust in you to fall; all this we ask through Jesus Christ our Lord."
