Stewardship Reflections

04/07/2019

Once again this week we are reminded of what a loving and merciful God we serve. The theme of the readings for this fifth Sunday of Lent are summed up beautifully in today's Gospel passage from Luke which recounts the story of the woman caught in adultery. After all those who would have stoned this woman leave the scene Christ says to her, "Neither do I condemn you. Go, and from now on do not sin anymore."

When we turn to God for forgiveness, He is indeed gracious and merciful. So much so, that not only will He forgive our sins without condemnation, He will make us completely new creations in Christ.

What is more amazing is that this all-perfect and holy God of ours draws so very near to us. Our sins do not drive Him from us, but rather to us so that He can set us free from them. Look carefully at Christ's actions and posture in the Gospel reading as He deals with both the crowd of people, the Scribes and Pharisees, and the adulterous woman. "All the people started coming to Him and he sat down and taught them." "He bent down and began to write with His finger." He "straightened up" when He confronted the Scribes and Pharisees about their own sins. And he "straightened up" when He assured the woman that He did not condemn her for her past. Like a skilled teacher, or loving "big brother," Christ bends down to where we are, He sits among us, He stands to confront us when needed and He stands to look us in the eye to remind us of our true dignity.

We're all unworthy of the great privilege of serving Him. But that is simply cause for greater joy in serving Him with all our hearts.

Twelve People in a Lifeboat

A youth minister was once teaching a class on ethics and as part of the class he chose twelve students and gave them the following scenario for discussion. The scenario was that the twelve were survivors of a shipwreck and their lifeboat only had room for eleven. The exercise was to discuss who should be sacrificed so that the boat wouldn't sink. The discussion was lively. The group found different reasons why each of them should be saved.

One young man was physically strong and they needed him to row the boat. One young woman was very intelligent so they needed her to figure out a way to survive. One girl in the group didn't have any outstanding quality. She wasn't pretty, athletic, artistic, or smart. As the discussion progressed, she started to feel that there was no reason for her to be saved. Finally she blurted out, "Just throw me overboard; I'm not good for anything." There was a stunned silence. No one answered her. No one said anything. That's exactly what they had all been thinking.

That night, the "average" girl tried to kill herself. Thanks be to God, she didn't succeed. The experience profoundly changed every member of that group. They finally understood what it really means to love one's neighbor as oneself. It means to value them for who they are, not for what they can do. Have we really learned that lesson? If not, we will never be able to condemn the sin and love the sinner, as Jesus teaches us to do.
