Stewardship Bulletin Reflection
June 30, 2019

Today's readings take us back to the basics, inviting us to reflect honestly on our deepest priorities in life. In today's Gospel, from Luke, Christ refers to the struggle to put Him above all else as He encounters two "would-be" disciples on His way to Jerusalem.

'Follow me,'" Jesus says to the first man. "But he replied, 'Lord let me go first and bury my father.' The other said, "I will follow you, Lord, but first let me say farewell to my family at home." These two want to follow Christ, but only on their own terms, and only after taking care of some other, more pressing matters (at least in their own minds).

To this, Christ says thanks, but no thanks! Following Him requires an unqualified "yes" not a "yes, but..." We are called to put Christ and His kingdom ahead of our own plans if we truly wish to be His disciples and to find victory in the battle of selfishness. Living stewardship as a way of life can go a long way in arming us for victory. A stewardship way of life provides us with a custom-made "training plan" — the commitment to a specific offering of our time, talent and treasure to the Kingdom of God. It is a plan discerned through prayer, and by looking at the realities of our unique circumstances, strengths and limitations.


The daily discipline of committing to the plan strengthens us and helps us gradually move away from the "yes, but" attitude and towards an unqualified "yes!" to Christ and His will. Do not be afraid to give the best of yourself and your gifts to Christ. He deserves nothing less. And this way of life, while challenging, will be characterized by a joy and peace that only comes from living for Him.

Embarrassing

Prior to coming to Parsons I was the Pastor of four small rural parishes in Western Kingman County. They were Sacred Heart in Cunningham with 57 families and 109 individuals; St Leo in St Leo with 49 families and 125 individuals; St Peter in Willowdale with 29 families and 62 individuals; St John in Zenda with 35 families and 65 individuals; for a grand total of 170 families and 361 individuals. Here at St. Patricks we have registered 642 families equalling approximately 1611 individuals, so St. Patricks is nearly 4x the size of all four of my previous parishes combined. I mention all of this because more than once at a Sunday Mass, I have had to serve as lector, because the scheduled lector did not show or was unable to find another lector to fill in for them. In all my 5 years at my previous parishes, working with a much smaller number of people, never once was I without a lector at a Sunday Mass. Quite frankly it is embarrassing that in a parish our size, it has happened more than once. So one of two things needs to happen. Either we accept that we just don't have enough committed people to serve as lectors for the 3 Masses we have on a weekend and therefore permanently cancel one of the Masses, OR people step-up and make a commitment to volunteer to serve as lectors. The choice is in all of your hands. If you choose the 2nd option then please contact the parish office about becoming a lector and if you would rather we pursue the first option, then simply do nothing.
