Stewardship Bulletin Reflection
January 16, 2022

The story found in today's Gospel reading of the wedding feast at Cana is certainly a familiar one. At the request of his mother, Jesus is asked to perform his first public miracle. The wedding banquet host, for his part, is facing public humiliation for falling short of his guests' expectations because he has run out of wine. For Jesus's part, the stakes which he faces before the assembled wedding guests are even greater. By performing his first public miracle, Jesus's "hour" is about to begin. The generous and abundant gift of wine, perhaps as much as one-hundred and eighty gallons of the very best fruit of the vine, would indeed signal the beginning of Jesus's public ministry. Having "so revealed his glory," the miracle at Cana would send him along the path to Calvary, where an even greater gift of redemption would soon be given.

Value Them Both Presentation:
Fr Bernie Gorges, will offer a pro-life presentation on Saturday, January 15th in the St. Patrick Catholic School gymnasium following Mass. This interdenominational event is part of a statewide Value Them Both Movement. What's at stake: A recent state court ruling could overturn every abortion regulation now in Kansas law. Those existing protections prevent late-term abortions, taxpayer funding of abortions, and a minor getting an abortion without a parent's consent. Passing the Value Them Both Amendment is essential to ensuring that these crucial restrictions remain in Kansas law. If we do not act and pass the Value Them Both Amendment, abortions up until the moment of birth could occur in Kansas. Make sure you invite Jesus and Mary!
Johnny Carson (who hosted the Tonight Show for 30 years), was interviewing an eight-year-old boy one night. The young man was asked to appear on the Late Show because he had rescued two friends from a coal mine outside his hometown in West Virginia. As Johnny questioned him, it became apparent that the boy was a Christian. Johnny asked him if he attended Sunday school. When the boy said he did, Johnny inquired, "What are you learning in Sunday school?" "Last week," the boy replied, "our lesson was about how Jesus went to a wedding and turned water into wine." The audience burst into laughter and applause. Keeping a straight face, Johnny asked, "And what did you learn from that story?" The boy squirmed in his chair. It was apparent he hadn't thought about this. But then he lifted up his face and said, "If you're going to have a wedding, make sure you invite Jesus and Mary!" And that is precisely the message of today's Gospel: make sure you invite Jesus and Mary wherever you live and wherever you go – they are the only ones you'll ever need. In other words, today's Gospel lesson is about the sufficiency of Christ in our lives and the power of his Mother's intercession.
