Stewardship Bulletin Reflection
January 30, 2022
Fourth Sunday in Ordinary Time

How do I know if the Time, Talent and Treasure I offer God in grateful return is "enough?"
What is the measure?


St. Paul tells us in the Second Reading today — the "measure" is the love that we put into each of these aspects of our lives. "If I have all faith so as to move mountains, but do not have love, I am nothing. If I give away everything I own and hand my body over so that I may boast but do not have love, I gain nothing." God is not after a particular number. What He wants us to give over to Him is our very selves.

Real love is not a sentiment. Real love is manifested in living a virtuous life. We read later in St. Paul's letter that real love takes strength: it is patient, kind, humble, other-centered, truth-seeking, and long-suffering. Love is the heroic giving of oneself even when it is uncomfortable; especially then. Love looks like Jesus. It lives like Jesus.

Sometimes, living like Jesus is difficult. We see this in the Gospel Reading today where we find Jesus in action, preaching in the synagogue in His hometown. He speaks truth to the people He loves, the ones He grew up with and shared His early days with. How do they respond? They are filled with fury and run Him out of town, intent on throwing Him from a cliff! Yet Jesus is undeterred. He passes right through them and presses forward with the mission His Father has entrusted to Him. We are called to live with this same strength and determination, fueled by the power of love and by gratitude for all God has given us.

Do You Pass the Love Test?

Our second reading today, from St. Paul's Letter to the Corinthians, is the most popular choice of readings for a Nuptial (Wedding) Mass. Of course it is quite obvious why it is such a popular choice among engaged couples, because it speaks of love and it is love that is upon their minds as they approach and celebrate their wedding day. However, St. Paul did not write this treatise on love with weddings in mind, rather he had in mind simply the vocation (the call) of every Christian. That as Christians who are made in the image of God, who as attested by St. John "is Love," we too are called to be a people of love. However, in our fallen world, we often confuse and mis-define what comprises true love. And it is the true nature of love that is revealed to us by St. Paul, but is it the love that we strive to live and express in our lives? If it were a test would we pass? Read the below excerpt by replacing the word "Love/it" with God and we can see how clearly and perfectly it defines God, He passes the love test, of course because He is Love. But read it again and insert your name for the word "Love/it". Does it as clearly define who you are? Does it define how you love? Would you get a passing grade on the love test? If not, if you would at least partially fail the test, as I'm sure we all would, then strive to get a better grade. Strive to change whatever is lacking in your life, in your love, so that we can truly become a people of Love, the Love that God has created us to share.

Love is patient, love is kind.
It is not jealous, it is not pompous,
It is not inflated, it is not rude,
it does not seek its own interests,
it is not quick-tempered, it does not brood over injury, it does not rejoice over wrongdoing but rejoices with the truth.
It bears all things, believes all things,
hopes all things, endures all things.
