**Stewardship Bulletin Reflection**  
 February 20, 2022 —  
 Seventh Sunday in Ordinary Time

In today's Gospel, taken from the sixth chapter of Luke, Jesus offers a very challenging, seemingly impossible approach to daily life. "Love your enemies, do good to those who hate you, bless those who curse you, pray for those who mistreat you. To the person who strikes you on one cheek, offer the other one as well, and from the person who takes your cloak do not withhold even your tunic." It makes one want to say, "Seriously, Lord?" And He doesn't stop there. Jesus adds, "Give to everyone who asks of you, and from the one who takes what is yours do not demand it back."  
 It seems so unfair! That is, unless we look at this way of life from a stewardship point of view. Then, not only does it seem doable (though challenging), but it also actually makes perfect sense. A steward understands clearly that all he has and all that he is — his very life — is a gift from God given to him from an unfathomable abundance of love. This changes everything! This means "my" cloak, "my" tunic, "my" money, and time — all of it ultimately belongs to God. He has entrusted these things to each of us in love to use for His purposes and His glory. Does this mean we are to be passive "doormats" to anyone who wants to take advantage of us? Certainly not. Jesus explains this in the next verse of this passage when He says, "Do to others as you would have them do to you." There is nothing wrong with loving oneself since God loves us and has made us in His own image and likeness. Jesus is simply asking that we also approach others, and the sharing of our gifts, with this same attitude. He is giving us a definition here of real love, a steward's love!

**The Scarlet and the Black**  
 This limitless love of God is what changes hearts; it's what changes the world. In 1983 a movie came out called "The Scarlet and the Black." It starred Gregory Peck and Christopher Plummer. The movie is based on a true story. It told the story of Monsignor Hugh O'Flaherty, an Irish priest who was working in the Vatican when Rome was occupied by Nazi troops during World War II. This monsignor organized a secret underground network to hide and protect allied soldiers who had been shot down and Jews who were being persecuted. The drama of the story comes from the ongoing battle of wits between Monsignor O'Flaherty and the German Commander of the occupied city, Colonel Herbert Kappal. The Vatican Monsignor outsmarts the Germans long enough to save thousands of lives, but many others are lost. When the allied forces reach the outskirts of the city and the Germans are penned in, Colonel Kappal arranges a secret meeting with Monsignor O'Flaherty. He asks the Monsignor to use his underground network to take the Colonel's wife and children to safety in Switzerland. The Monsignor is flabbergasted that this unscrupulous enemy would have the gall to ask for such a favor. He chastises him for his evil ways and walks off. Only later, when the Colonel is captured and under interrogation by the allies does he discover that the Monsignor had successfully saved his family. While the German colonel was under arrest in Rome for the remainder of the war, Monsignor O'Flaherty visited him regularly. Eventually, Colonel Kappal repented and was received into the Church. This is one example of the power of God's limitless love. He never gives up on us, because he knows that he can save us, change us, and lead us closer to him.
