"By This They Will Know"

In this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus offers His disciples a profound command at the Last Supper:

"I give you a new commandment, that you love one another. Just as I have loved you, you also should love one another. By this everyone will know that you are This is not a suggestion —it is the defining mark of Christian discipleship. The world will not recognize us by our buildings, our programs, or even our doctrines alone—but by the way we love. And true love, as Christ shows us, always takes the shape of self-giving. This Gospel connects beautifully with the Diocese of Wichita's stewardship way of life, defined as:

"The grateful response of a Christian disciple who recognizes and receives God's gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor." Stewardship is not a fundraising program—it's a way of living out this new commandment. It means seeing our time, talent, and treasure not as things we own, but as gifts we've been entrusted with, called to return in love. The diocesan capital campaign, "One Family Fully Alive in Christ," is a living expression of that stewardship. Its goal is not simply to improve facilities or fund ministries—it is to strengthen the entire body of Christ across our diocese. It seeks to invest in seminarian formation, parish needs, Catholic schools, and the spiritual life of families. In short, it's about becoming more fully alive in love and mission together.

This campaign invites each of us to reflect: How is God calling me to respond? How can my grateful heart help build up the Church—not only here at St. Patrick's, but throughout our diocesan family?

Let us never forget that love is not only a feeling, but a decision—an action. Stewardship is love in action. And when we live this out together, as one family, we fulfill Christ's command: "By this they will know that you are my disciples."

May we continue to grow in love, in gratitude, and in the joyful stewardship that leads us deeper into the heart of Christ.

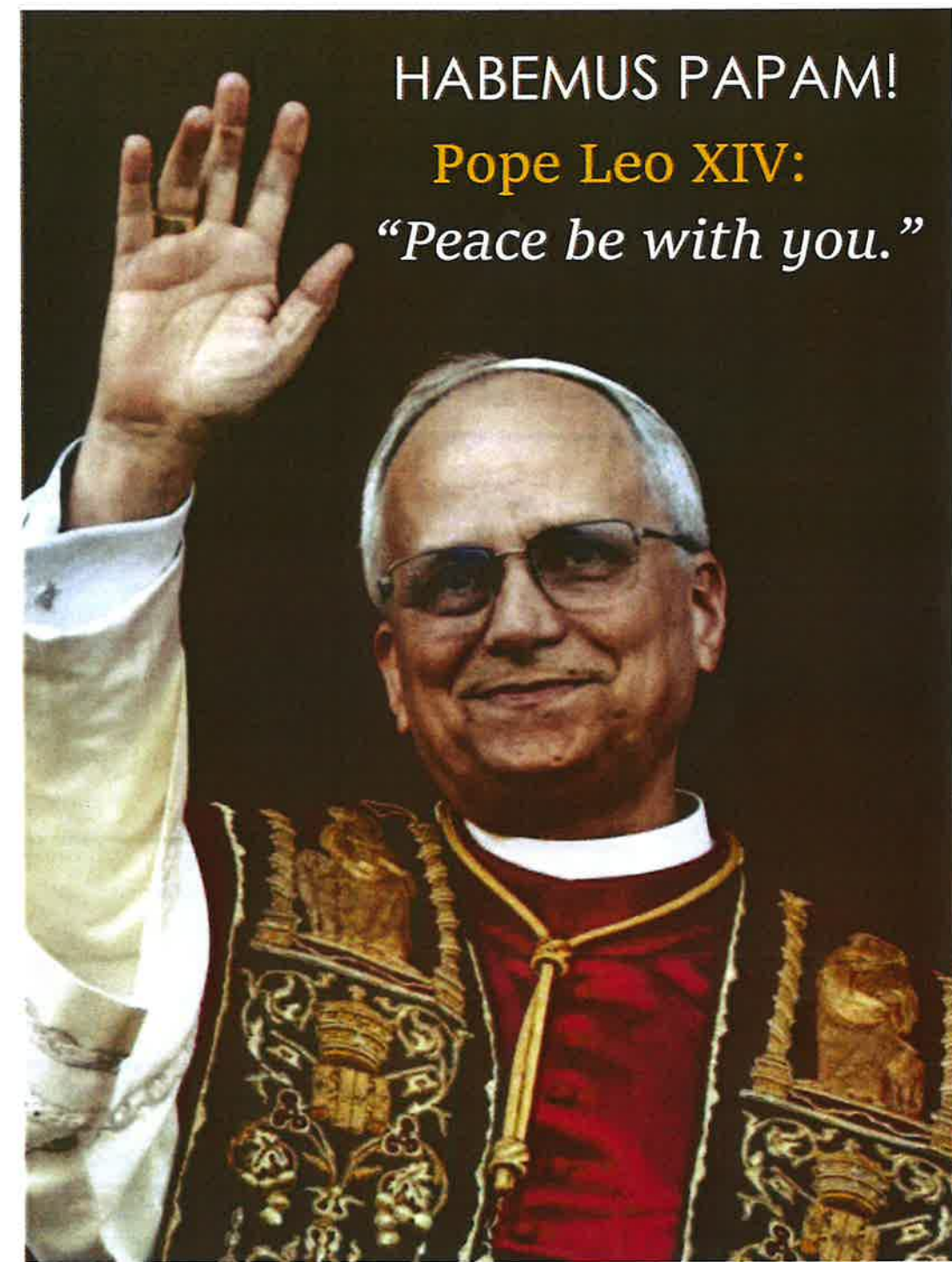
