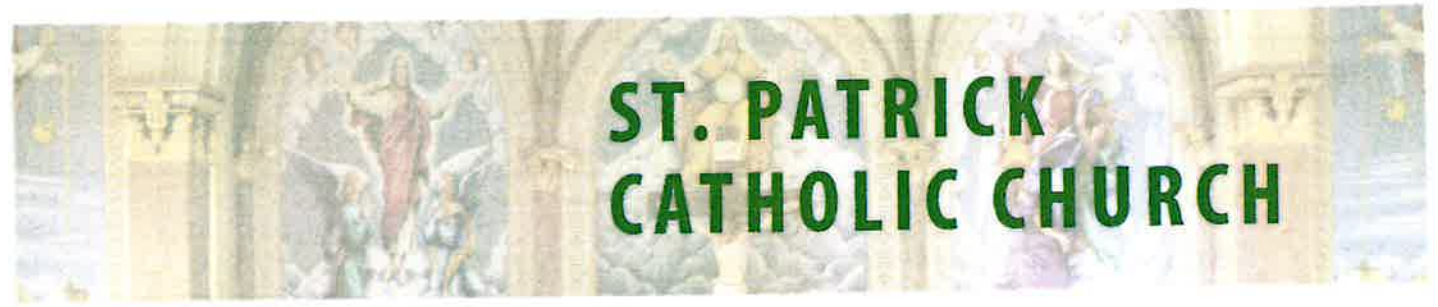

**The Spirit of Stewardship**

This Pentecost Sunday, as we hear Jesus promise the Advocate who "will teach you everything and remind you of all that I told you" (John 14:26), we are invited to listen for the Holy Spirit's guidance as we approach Commitment Weekend for One Family Fully Alive in Christ! Just as the Spirit filled the disciples on that first Pentecost, enabling them to speak boldly of God's mighty works, the same Spirit empowers us today to live as faithful stewards. The Diocese of Wichita defines stewardship as "the grateful response of a Christian disciple with gifts and shares these gifts in love of God and neighbor." After a month of prayer and discernment about our campaign, this weekend offers us the opportunity to reflect deeply on how the Spirit is calling us to respond. Stewardship, as we practice it in our diocese, is not merely about giving—it's about recognizing that all we have belongs to God and responding with grateful hearts. The first Christians, filled with the Holy Spirit, "devoted themselves to the teaching of the apostles and to the communal life" (Acts 2:42). Next weekend, June 14-15, we have the chance to demonstrate that same devotion through our campaign commitments. As we've learned over these past weeks, our participation in One Family Fully Alive in Christ! is a concrete way to strengthen our Catholic community and serve our neighbors in need. The Holy Spirit, who Jesus promised would "remind you of all that I told you," calls us to remember Christ's words: "By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13:35). Our stewardship response to this campaign—whether through time, talent, or treasure—is one tangible way we love our Catholic family. As you prepare for Commitment Weekend, ask the Spirit to guide your discernment. What is God calling you to offer? How can your response reflect the grateful heart of a true steward? May the Spirit of Pentecost inspire us to respond generously, trusting that God will bless our offerings as He blessed the disciples' bold witness on that first Pentecost.
