The Father's Heart: Trinity, Fatherhood, and Stewardship
 This weekend we celebrate both Holy Trinity Sunday and Father's
 Day, giving us a beautiful opportunity to reflect on the heart of our
 faith and the gift of fatherhood that flows from it. In the mystery of
 the Trinity, we encounter God the Father as the eternal source of
 all love, all life, and all the gifts we've been given to steward.
 When we pray "Our Father," we're not just reciting familiar words--
 we're entering into the very life of the Trinity. God the Father, in
 perfect love with the Son through the Holy Spirit, shows us what
 true fatherhood looks like. His love is completely self-giving,
 holding nothing back, pouring out everything for our good. This
 divine fatherhood becomes the model for all human fatherhood
 and, indeed, for all Christian stewardship.
 The fathers among us—biological fathers, spiritual fathers, and
 father figures—are called to reflect this Trinitarian love in their daily
 lives. Just as God the Father entrusts His Son with our salvation
 and entrusts us with His creation, earthly fathers are entrusted with
 the precious gift of family. They become stewards of young hearts,
 minds, and souls, called to nurture, protect, and guide with the
 same generous love they've received from their heavenly Father.
 But this call to stewardship extends beyond fathers to all of us. As
 children of our heavenly Father, we're all entrusted with gifts—our
 time, talents, and treasures—that ultimately belong to Him. Our
 stewardship isn't just about money in the collection basket (though
 that's part of it!). It's about recognizing that everything we have
 flows from the Father's generous heart and is meant to be shared
 in that same spirit of love.
 When we embrace stewardship as the Diocese of Wichita teaches,
 we're actually living out our identity as children of the Trinity. We
 give because we've been given to. We serve because we've been
 served. We love because He first loved us. In this way, every act of
 stewardship becomes a prayer, a participation in the very life of
 God.
 This Father's Day, let's pray for all fathers that they might grow
 daily in reflecting their heavenly Father's love. And let's ask
 ourselves: How is God the Father calling me to be a better steward
 of the gifts He's entrusted to me? How can I share His love more
 generously with those around me?
 In the name of the Father, and of the Son, and of the Holy Spirit,
 may we all grow in grateful stewardship of the abundant life we've
 been given.
