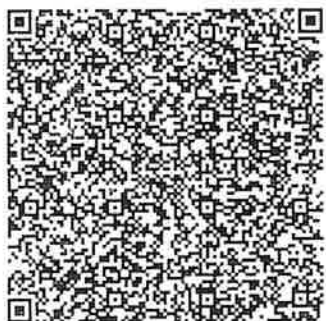


Walk in Sister's Shoes... St. Katharine Drexel fund
